Rosalie and Tony Purcell 6881 Maroondah Highway Yarck


Medium size country garden full of colour with irises, daphne, foxgloves, roses, salvias, many bulbs and natives. There are 24 different maples spread throughout the garden.

Attraction: Fundraising for Kellock Lodge, Alexandra.


