23 Patagorang Place Buxton

Large country garden with approximately 90 standard roses, natives, conifers, Japanese maples, camellias, ferns, and hundreds of bulbs. Wisteria arbour and rustic sculptures and items throughout the garden.

Attractions: *Sausage Sizzle. Fundraiser for Marysville Primary School 10.30am-3.30pm*

**2 Leanne McCready and Allan Bull
Bullalea Park**

28 Patagorang Place Buxton

Country garden of 1.75 acres with extensive vegetable garden, callistemon bird walk, butterfly garden, rose and wisteria arbour, firepit and sculptures throughout the garden.

Attractions: *Darren Gilbert Sculptures and the Little Yellow Van (coffee).*

**3 Michelle Fleming and Michael Heyes
12 Glendale Lane Taggerty**

Large country garden with Japanese maples, hydrangeas, a native garden with dry creek bed, perennial gardens, a recycled timber arbour and a garden full of lush, leafy plants.

Attractions: *Country Farm Perennials (unique and rare seeds) and Blaze Rustic Furniture (birdhouses).*

**6 Georgie and Will Leckey
Two Rivers Lodge**

38 Moloneys Road Acheron

Large country garden with fruit and vegetable planting, camellia hedging and deciduous trees. Substantial hornbeam hedging and large sweeping garden bed with mass planting at entrance.

Attractions: *The Bees Needs (plants) and FD Ryan Toolmakers (handmade garden stakes)*

**7 Marian Rennie
Ariah Park**

132 Breakaway Road Acheron

Large country garden that was started in 1949. Mature dogwoods, magnolias, rhododendrons and many shrubs and bulbs providing a riot of colour. Sculptures throughout the garden.

Attractions: *Licensed café and art gallery.*
Ways to the Future with a series of guest speakers on sustainability.

**8 Rosalie and Tony Purcell
6881 Maroondah Highway Yarck**

Medium size country garden full of colour with irises, daphne, foxgloves, roses, salvias, many bulbs and natives. There are 24 different maples spread throughout the garden.

Attractions: *Vicki Combridge Sculpture and Arts and Baxter and Co (gifts and homewares).*

**9 Attunga Gardens
82 Rollasons Road Thornton**

A beautifully designed large garden by well-known Australian landscape architect and designer, Paul Bangay. Extensive new gardens have been designed and established over the last four years.

Attraction: *Fundraising for Kellock Lodge, Alexandra.*

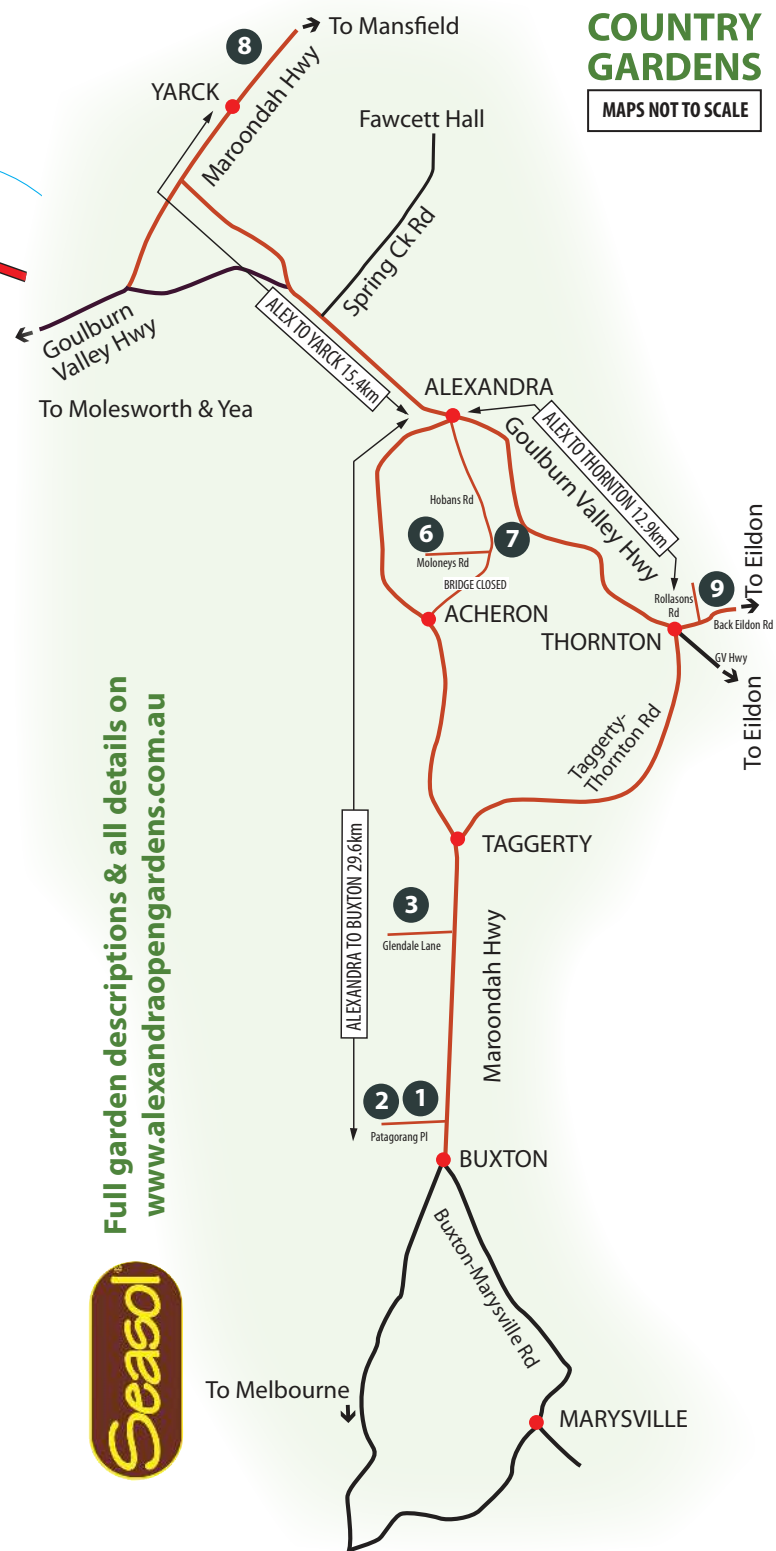
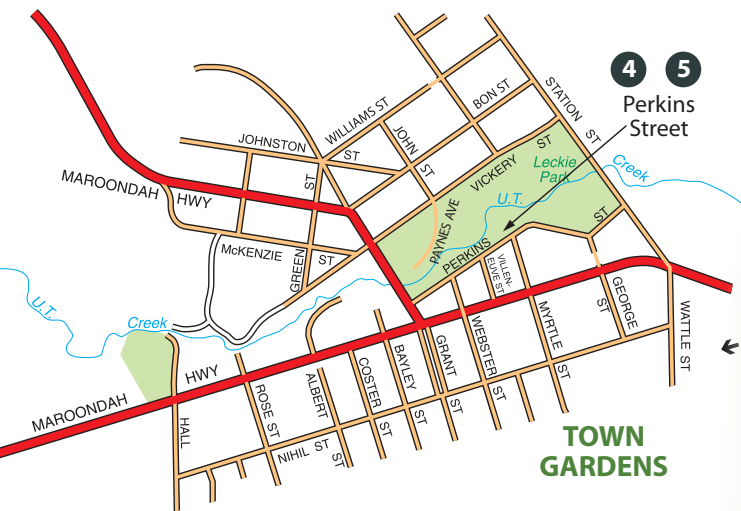
